This mailing is being sent to all synodical pastors and to accredited lay delegates, visitors and guests whose registration forms have been submitted to the synod office.

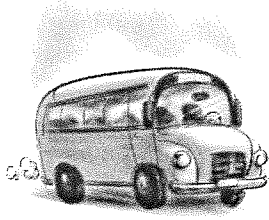
### 1. BULLETIN OF REPORTS:

The enclosed BULLETIN OF REPORTS is your primary working document for the Assembly; **please be sure to bring it with you, as there will be no additional copies provided.** Some additional items will be provided to you in a Supplement when you register at Wilfrid Laurier University

### 2. NEW DELEGATE ORIENTATION:

An orientation session for new delegates will be held at 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Thursday, July 5, 2012 at Waterloo Lutheran Seminary – Room S201.

### 3. GROUND TRANSPORTATION:



The Local Arrangements Committee will arrange shuttle service for all delegates and registered visitors arriving at Pearson International Airport in Toronto. Delegates who arrive at Terminal 1 and 3 should go to the Ground Transportation Desk and ask for Airways Transit. Delegates arriving by Greyhound Bus or VIA will be met at the respective stations as indicated on your Registration Form.

### 4. MAPS:

Directions and a map showing the location of St. John's Lutheran Church, Waterloo, (the site of the Ordination Service on Friday, July 6) and the Waterloo Motor Inn, Waterloo, (the site of the Eastern Synod Banquet on Saturday, July 7) will be available at the Hospitality Desk.

### 5. ORDINATION AND EASTERN SYNOD BANQUET TRANSPORTATION:

Bus transportation will be provided for those who sign up at the Hospitality Desk.

### 6. PARKING:

- Only registered delegates staying at Wilfrid Laurier University will be issued parking passes at the registration table.
- Parking for registered delegates and visitors staying off-site will be available in lots 3A (Conference Service lot) and in lot 32 (St. Michael's). Off-site delegates can stop at the Information Kiosk located at the main university entrance off of University Avenue to purchase a parking permit for \$7.00 per day (cash) - flat rate until 11:00pm. Upon purchasing their pass they will be directed to the appropriate parking lot. In addition, it is possible to purchase hourly or day parking in the "Pay and Display" lot 4 or 20 (\$7.00/day - cash or credit card).
- Parking charges only apply Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. After 4:30 p.m. on weekdays and anytime on weekends, there is no charge for parking and guests can park in any lot (except meters and Pay and Display lot 4 or 20). Parking on the street is available for 3 hours only and this is strictly enforced by the City of Waterloo.

**Reminder:** All residence rooms are supplied with a pillow, blanket, linens, towels, soap and a cup. (If you prefer very large towels, wash cloths, or pillows you will need to bring your own.)

**Please Note:** if you have arranged off-site accommodation, the recommended stipend paid by congregations is set at double occupancy rates - \$70.67 per person per night including taxes = \$212.01 for three nights.

**10. BIBLE STUDY:**

We are pleased to announce that Michael Harvey will be our Bible Study leader throughout the Assembly. In 2004, Michael Harvey gave up a high-flying job in the City of London to teach church leaders to see new possibilities, using an approach that quickly became established as Back to Church Sunday. Michael challenges churches of all sizes to double their congregation in a day - by daring to invite their friends. The results have been remarkable. The idea is for individuals in the pews to invite their friends with a simple question "Would you like to come to church with me and afterwards why don't we have Sunday lunch together?" The key to success, say the organizers, is the personal invitation and attention. "It takes a very brave person to walk into a church on their own nowadays," says Michael, "but God is still speaking to them. All they need is a gentle invitation." Plan to be inspired.

GLUTEN-FREE: Please look for the sign up sheet at registration if you would prefer gluten free wafers for communion at opening and closing worship.

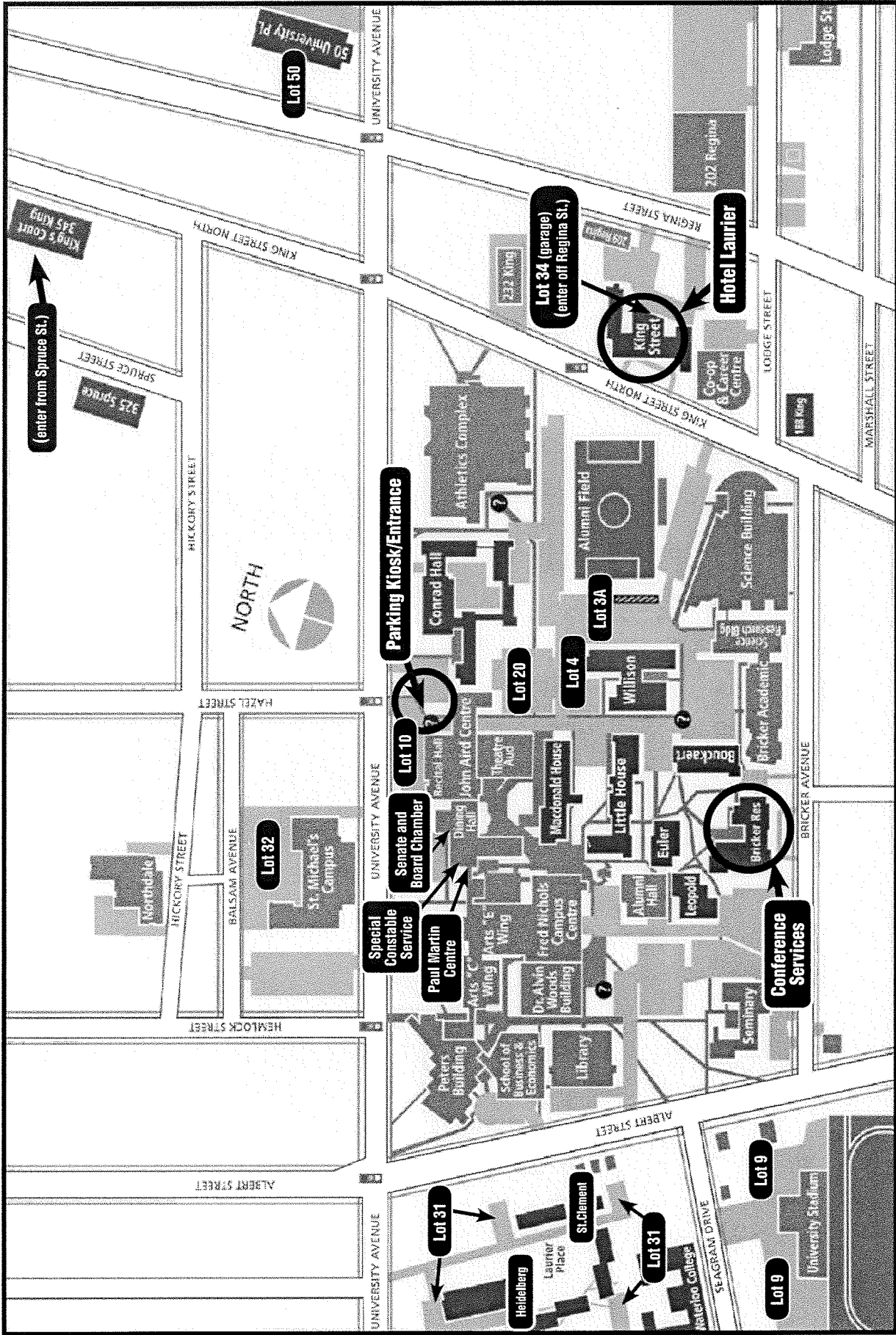
CHOIR: Join the choir for Ordination (Friday evening) under director Scott Knarr; rehearsals during Assembly days.
