The Sisters of Saint John the Divine invite you to explore an expression of new monasticism rooted in the Anglican tradition. Companions will develop a rhythm of life including public and private prayer, engage in service to others, and learn to live in intentional community.

In addition you will:

- cultivate an appreciation for counter-cultural values while growing in peace and freedom
- deepen your rootedness and spiritual intimacy, with God and each other in community
- discover a personal path to spiritual growth and transformation
- discern individual gifts and vocation

Room and board are provided, and most living expenses are covered by the Sisterhood. Companions, in turn, use their gifts to share in the work of ministry and have the same free time, retreat opportunities, and vacation as the Sisters.

A Love of Prayer

Learn to pray alongside a community steeped in a life of prayer, contemplation and meditation, while also participating in the daily liturgical rhythm of the convent.

A Commitment to Work

Practice the presence of God while participating in work, both inside the convent and in service to the world.

A Lifetime of Study

Grow in wisdom and knowledge through spiritual formation courses offered jointly by the Sisterhood and Wycliffe College (University of Toronto), and those who are eligible may apply for academic credit.
