As of September 30th, benevolence offerings were tracking 2.6% below the amount that was received for the comparable year-to-date period in 2024 and showing a greater than 8% decrease over the last two years.

We continue to budget a decline of benevolence offering – a critical piece of the overall operating budget. Over 35% of the total Eastern Synod budget is supported by benevolence offerings.
