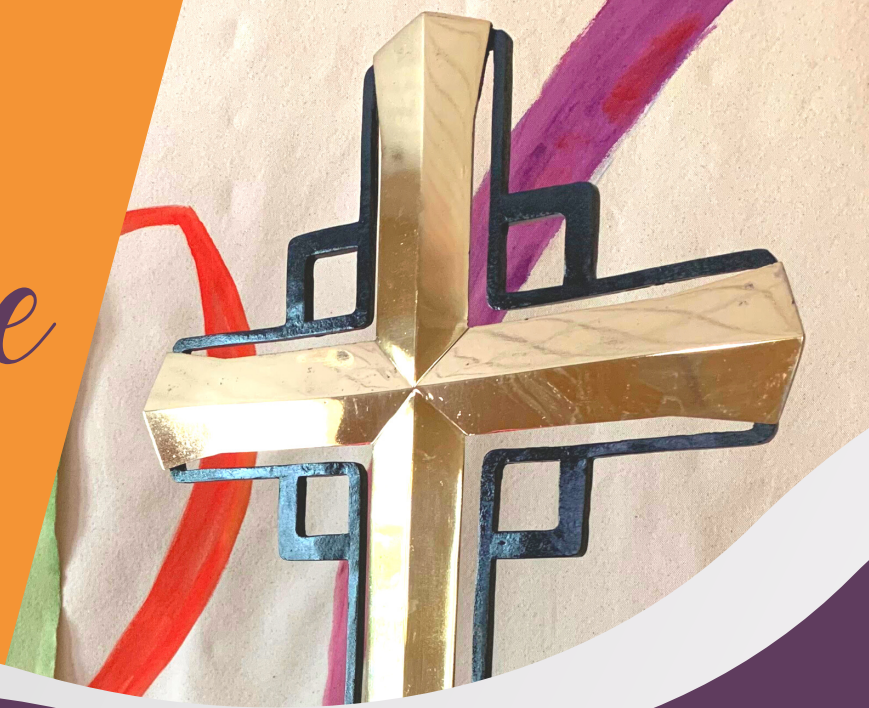

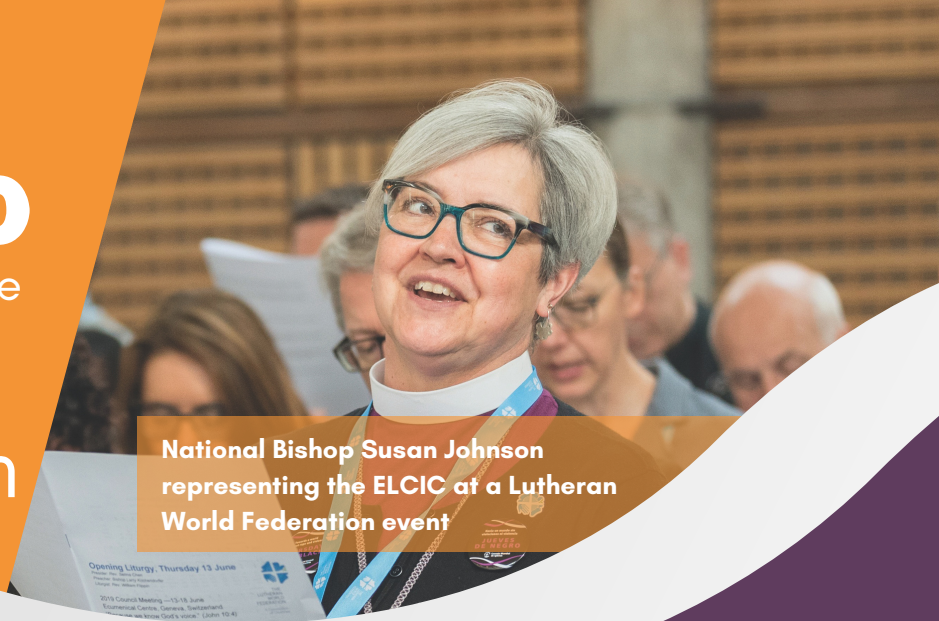

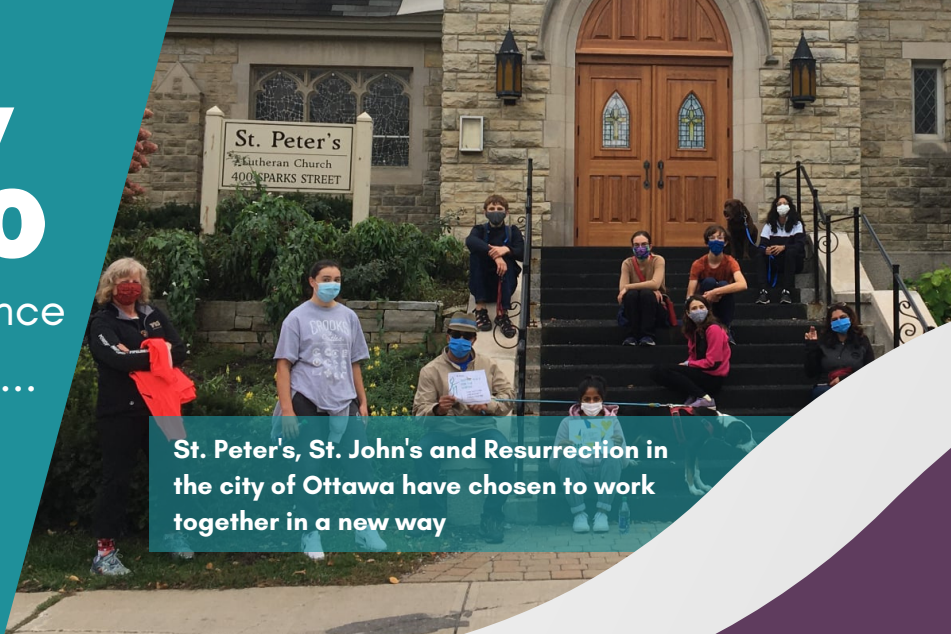

Providing a strong and present voice in the areas of **public policy, racial justice, reconciliation, and climate justice**



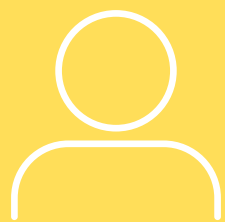

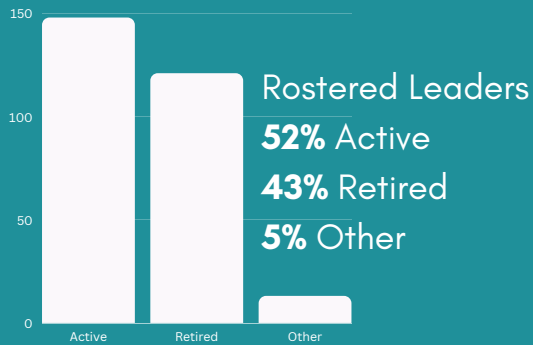

Rostered Leaders serve in a variety of specialized areas such as military, prison and nursing chaplains

5% of Benevolence Offering is needed to support the Eastern Synod Retiree Benefit Plan

On average, 2-3 new candidates for ministry enter the candidacy process per year
