(To July 31st, 2019)

Benevolence offerings remitted to the Synod office continue to track well below those received for the comparable period in 2018, a decrease of more than 6% (\$41,000). Offerings designated for Canadian Lutheran World Relief show a decline of about 2%. The Eastern Synod is making 10 full scholarships available to lay persons who will be accompanying a rostered leader from their congregation in the upcoming 2019-2020 Missional Leadership Cohort.

Scholarships will be offered on a first come, first served basis, for up to two lay participants per congregation whose pastor or deacon is also registered for the programme.

The 2018-2019 cohort included several Eastern Synod participants and we are hoping to encourage five or more new congregational teams to come to life in 2019-2020.
